## Speaking Hope to Asia

Most of Asia is lacking proper infrastructure, making it hard for Gospel workers to make personal contact in remote regions. It is not unusual for workers to walk for 5-6 days in order to reach a remote village. When they get there, they sometimes find more than half the people illiterate. It is difficult to communicate the Gospel to them; however, God always has a way.

### Radio.

The Sowers Ministry is broadcasting radio messages. Every week millions of people hear about the subjects of God, family, relationships, health and finances. The voice of Hope instantly goes to places where it would take people days and even weeks to reach.

The radio broadcast is changing lives.

Amrita KC came from a Hindu background. A Christian friend told her about our radio program. Amrita used to have relationship problems. In time, Amrita began to change her thinking. She says, "I learned to keep strife away and my relationships began to prosper." Today, Amrita has reconciled her relationships. And above all, she is coming to the church regularly.

In a developing country, radio broadcasts are a big part of people's lives, because we can capture their hearts. Many have no basic education. They need all sorts of training and practical lessons. Isolated believers can listen to the radio once or twice a week in their own language.

You can play a vital part by speaking Hope to millions of lost people in Asia.

A half-hour radio broadcast costs us \$130 to produce and an hour's broadcast costs \$250. You can also sponsor partial radio broadcasts for only \$35. Let us take the opportunity we now have with modern technology. Together, we can speak the voice of Hope that turns people to their Savior.

## *“I burnt my wife’s Bible”*

My name is Zhu (pictured above). I want to share my testimony about how God delivered me from four years of prison labor camp.

My child had had a heart problem since the age of two and he was very sick. We took him to witch doctors and tried everything, but nothing worked. One day my sister came to visit and told us that Jesus can heal the sick. I did not want a Western god in our home. I became very angry when she took my child to a Christian gathering to be prayed for.

One night, I caught my wife reading her Bible. She was sobbing for our sick child, asking God to heal him. I did not like what I saw, so I took her Bible and burned it.

One night I dreamt that my son had died. My wife asked me about my dream, and told me that God was trying to speak to me in my dream and reveal His goodness. She said: “Please give me one chance to prove to you that my God is good.” I agreed and we began to pray for our son. After a week our son began to recover.

I began to study the Bible and my wife held prayer meetings at home. The numbers grew from forty to fifty people. There was much joy as our son began to get stronger. Six months had gone by and I decided to follow Christ with my whole heart. One year passed and our son was completely healed – and our marriage restored.

One night there was a loud noise in the village and twelve policemen came to our house. They took everything we owned and put my family into police custody. After three hours of interrogation the police finally let my family go; however, they kept me in prison. I was locked up for four years without even getting a trial. In the prison I met many other believers.

During those four years I had not seen my son and I began to worry. I got very sick and prayed, “Oh God, if it is your will, let me see my son once more before I die.” The government hospital did not have a lot of medication for me and my food was poor; I was left to die in the prison hospital.

My wife and some other Christian women went to the local police department and asked them if I could be released to die at home. Miraculously, after two weeks, the police let me go home. I was so sick that I threw up blood. Believers, who had not seen me for four years, took care of me.

Six months later I felt the Lord’s healing hand upon me and I made a vow to God. I told him that I would serve Him and provide Bible for families who have none.

*Since 2001, the Sowers Ministry has helped Zhu distribute 23,210 Bibles to China’s house churches. Zhu wants 10,000 Bibles this fall in order to meet the demands of revival breaking out. Please help and support the urgent need for Bibles.*
